

## “LA TRAGARA. THE PATH OF THE BRIGANDS”

With this magnificent excursion we will take you along the Path of the Tragara, which starts from the San Severino di Centola railway station and arrives at the Sanctuary of the Annunziata, in Licusati. The term "tragara" is the local name for the large boulders that occasionally roll down the valley. This path is better known as the "Path of the Brigands" precisely because it was used at the time of the Brigand Band of Nicola Marino di Centola. The first part of the route runs along part of the old, abandoned railway SA / RC, which crosses the fascist bridge of 1028, and passes through a small tunnel. Following the mule track we reach a beautiful centuries-old holm oak wood that grows on the side of Monte Bulgheria, until we reach the so-called “Sentinella's Balcony” overlooking the gorges of the Mingardo river and the Castle of San Severino. Further on we reach l'Epitaffio, a large wall running from North to South, visible from the mouth of the river, from the Molpa Hill and from the Rofrano pass, which pointed the way to reach the sea and vice versa. Eventually we arrive at the Sanctuary of the Annunziata, which stands on a small stony hill and dominates the entire Licusati valley.

**Departure:** uphill slope of the San Severino di Centola railway station



**Time** for average course 6 h

**Distance:** about 12 km round-trip

**Difference in altitude:** 350 m

**Equipment:** mandatory hiking shoes - optional sticks.

**In backpack:** Water, hat, raincoat.

**Path type:** Medium difficulty path

**Rating:** E (Hiking)
