

Caves, Sea and Nature

Take the path to Baia degli Infreschi. About 1 km from the start take a detour to the right which, going up, leads to the Grotta degli Iscolelli (Iscolelli Cave). From here, continuing further, you return to the main path from where you take the detour to the Cala Bianca beach. But before reaching the beach there is a detour on the right that leads to the Cala Bianca cave. The excursion will end with your feet soaking in the blue sea at Cala Bianca beach.

Grotta degli Iscolelli (n° speleo cadastre CP343): there is a large portal where prehistoric remains have been found.

Cave of Cala Bianca (n° speleo cadastre CP905): the entrance is a small well that can be easily overcome with the aid of a ladder that leads to a room with a richly concreted vault. At the bottom there are notable fills that have partially occluded some passages.
